## HOW TO ENTER CAPTURE ROTHERHAM

The photograph competition has 5 main categories Photographers can only enter one photo per category

- One image that captures your experience of Lockdown 2020.
- 2 Your favourite heritage building, monument or site in your local area.
- 3 All about Me; an image that captures the story of you (e.g qualities, beliefs & your individuality).
- 4 A special local place (somewhere you have visited during Lockdown).
- 5 Something that represents your connection to your community or local area.

We will award 2 prizes per category for 13-17-year olds and 18-25 years.

Each winner will receive £50 in vouchers!

We will also award 3 prizes of a Royal Society of Photography Annual Membership for the best photographs across all categories.

Winners will be invited to a prize giving ceremony, and a selection of the photographs will go on display as part of a temporary exhibition at Clifton Park Museum.

Entering the competition couldn't be easier. For your chance to win simply -

- 1 Take your picture on a camera or mobile phone and send it to heritage.youth@rotherham.gov.uk The deadline for entries is 14th August 5pm.
- 2 Create and send us the title, a description of your image, how it meets that category and why it is important to you.
- 3 Enter under 1 of the 5 different categories.
